

Data information declaration for exhibitors in application of Art. 12, 13 GDPR

Note: This data privacy statement applies to exhibitors with regard to the processing of personal data in the context of registration for the Future Of Festivals trade fair

In the following we inform you about the collection and processing of your personal data that we have received and collected in the context of (pre-)contractual relationships, e.g. after your personal telephone/e-mail contact request or sending the stand registration for the Future Of Festivals trade fair.

We process your personal data in compliance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG) and all other relevant laws. We process the personal data already known to us, which we have received and collected in the course of entering into (pre-)contractual relationships, exclusively for the purposes stated below.

Should we wish to process your personal data for a purpose not specified, we will inform you in advance in accordance with the statutory provisions.

1. What personal data do we process?

We process the following personal data:

2. Legal basis and purposes of data processing

In accordance with Article 6 Paragraph 1 Letters b), c) and f) of the GDPR, we use the above-mentioned personal data of our exhibitors and interested parties, provided that they or their employees are natural persons. We process this data for the conception, planning, organization, coordination and execution of the Future Of Festivals trade fair, in particular

either to answer your inquiry about the trade fair, the general availability of a stand space or specific questions about exhibitor activities at the Future Of Festivals trade fair by means of a detailed information package or

to send you a stand registration or

To inform you via our exhibitor mailings.

Our legitimate interest is a relevant and appropriate business relationship between you as an exhibitor and us as the organizer of the trade fair as well as the promotional use of your personal data. Specifically, we would like to inform you in detail about our company in general and our offers and win you over/retain you as an exhibitor.

The processing of personal data also takes place to comply with other legal obligations incumbent on us (in particular those under commercial and/or tax law) in accordance with Article 6 Paragraph 1 Letter c) GDPR.

You have the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data, which is carried out on the basis of Article 6 Para. 1 lit. f) GDPR, and to give reasons for this. The objection can be made informally and should, if possible, be sent via email to Mr. Stolt at email: robert@futureoffestivals.com

If you object, we will no longer process your personal data unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate reasons for the processing that outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms or the processing serves to assert, exercise or defend legal claims.

3. Duration of data processing

The data will generally be deleted as soon as it is no longer necessary to achieve the purpose for which it was collected, which is the case after three years at the latest. For the personal data from which a contract emerges, storage beyond the contract period is also required for tax purposes, to assert warranty claims and thus corresponds to the fulfillment of a legal obligation on our part in accordance with Article 6 Paragraph 1 Letter c) GDPR. In order to defend against claims, it is necessary that personal data is retained for the period in which claims can be asserted against our company. The retention period depends on contractual and/or legal limitation periods and the respective limitation requirements. The data will therefore be deleted after a period of 10 years at the latest, in accordance with the proof and storage obligations under, among other things, the Commercial Code and the Tax Code.

4. Categories of recipients of personal data

There will be no transfer to third countries.
